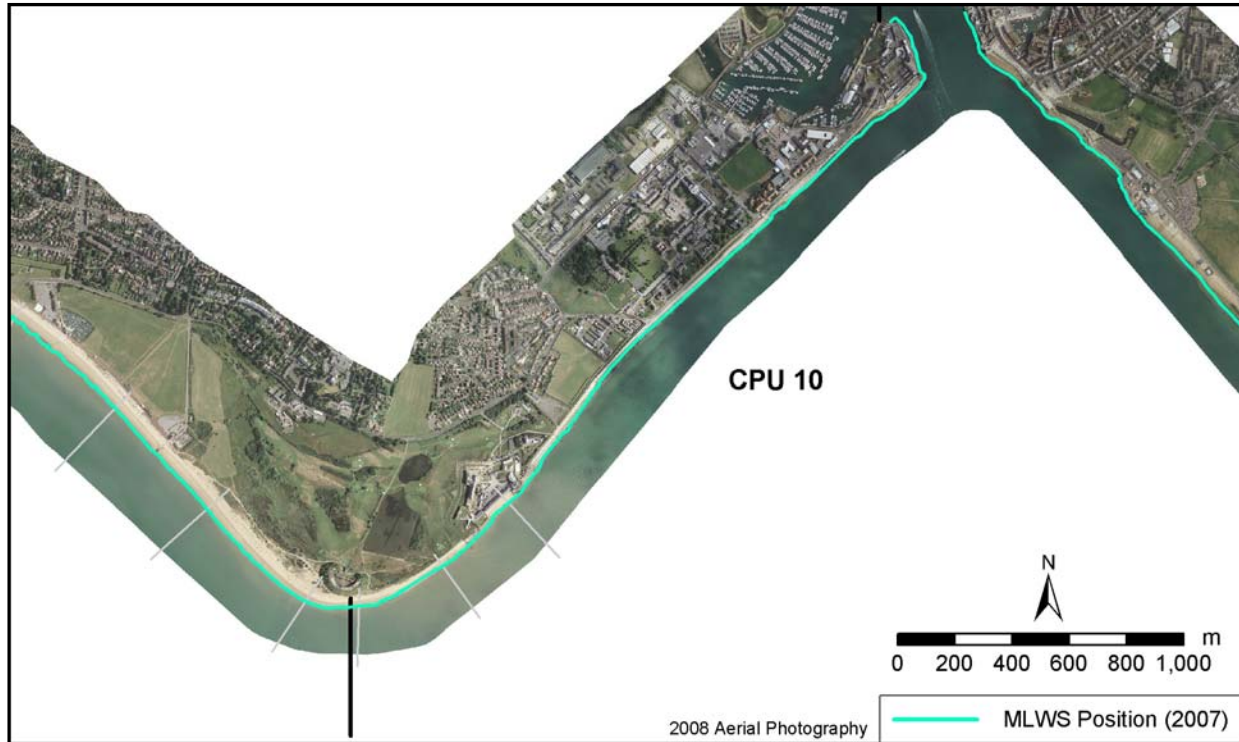

Portsmouth Harbour Entrance to Fort Gilkicker

Summary

The eastern part of the shoreline is protected by hard structures (with little beach material above MLWS) which grades into a wide, steep, undefended, gravel beach at the southern end, near Fort Gilkicker.

Survey Regime

<i>Lidar</i>	5 years	MLWN
<i>Habitat mapping</i>	5 Years	Extent of aerial photography
